Baydelta Maritime Honors OOCL for Its Environmental Stewardship

Baydelta Maritime, a logistics partner of OOCL, recently welcomed its new tug "Delta Billie" to its fleet at Pier 15. The "Delta Billie" is equipped with two Caterpillar 3516C main engines that meet the EPA Tier II emissions standards - higher than those set by the California Air Quality Board. "It's a significant reduction in emissions" stated Henning, "90% reduction in CO₂ emissions and

99% reduction in sulphur oxide (SO_x) emissions". The "Delta Billie" will be joined by its sister vessel, the "Delta Cathryn" in July 2009.
